There will be short monologues performed from stories collected from respondents to our Heritage Lottery questionnaire about exposure to asbestos in the 20th Century

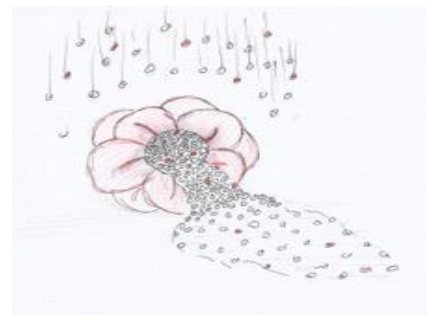
as well as a reading of the winning poem from our competition
